The Alfred Werner **Excellence Scholarship Program**

Bringing Talent to Switzerland

The program supports talented international students of chemistry to perform their Master of Science (MSc) studies in Switzerland. The scholars, nominated by the Swiss partner universities, are selected by a committee of professors and industry scientists.

Since 2013, 78 students from over 30 countries were granted an Alfred Werner Scholarship in the amount of 30'00 CHF. As of 2023, eight generations of students successfully completed their studies, many with distinction: The program met its expectations!

Well Educated – Well Integrated

Besides getting access to high level education, the scholars also receive support for their integration in our community. Networks such as the young Swiss Chemical Society or Women in Swiss Chemistry invite the scholars to actively participate.

Connecting Talent with Industry

In 2016, Lonza scientists and engineers invited the scholars to Visp to get to know each other. This first Meet&Greet became a regular event, which is now also open to the alumni: Talent meets industry - industry meets talent.

Many scholars were awarded prizes for their Masters' theses or won prizes for their research at scientific congresses.
